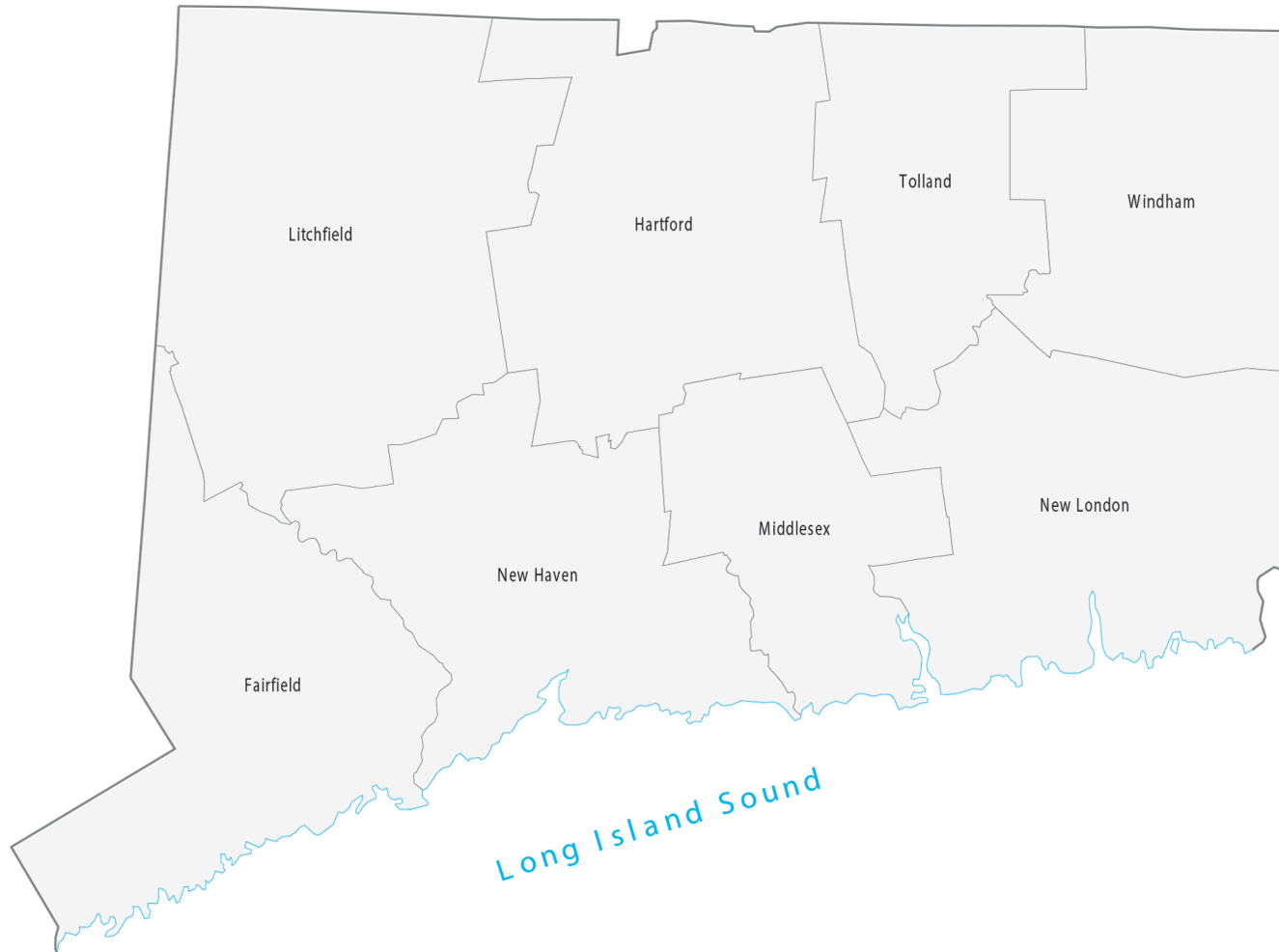

# Methodology

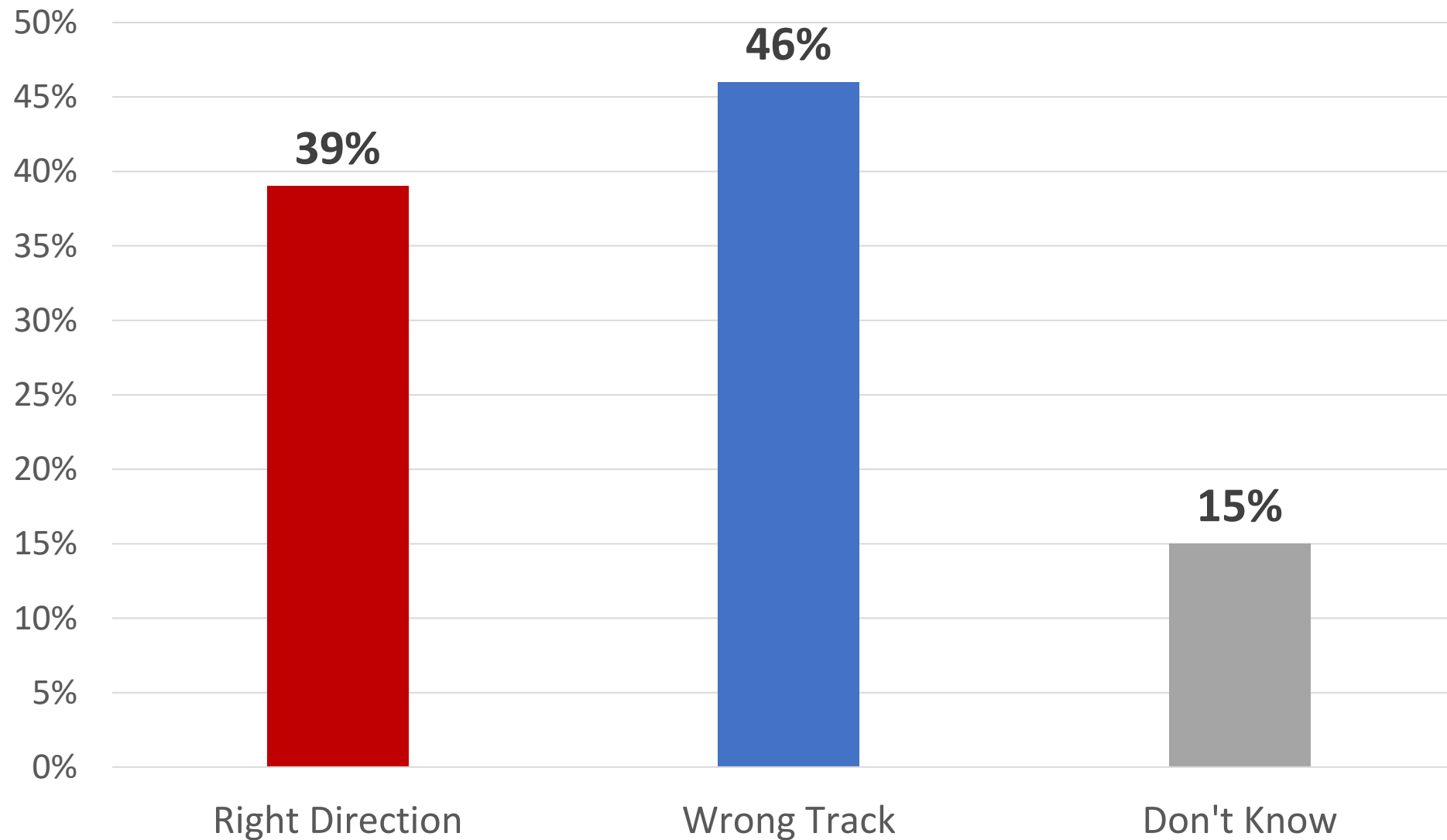
This Connecticut statewide survey was conducted among 500 likely general election voters between July 26-27, 2022.

Interviews included a mix of landline phone, mobile phone, and text-to-web. Interview selection was at random within predetermined election units. These units were structured to statistically correlate with actual statewide general election voter turnout.

The accuracy of the sample of 500 likely general election voters is within +/- 4.4% at a 95% confidence interval.

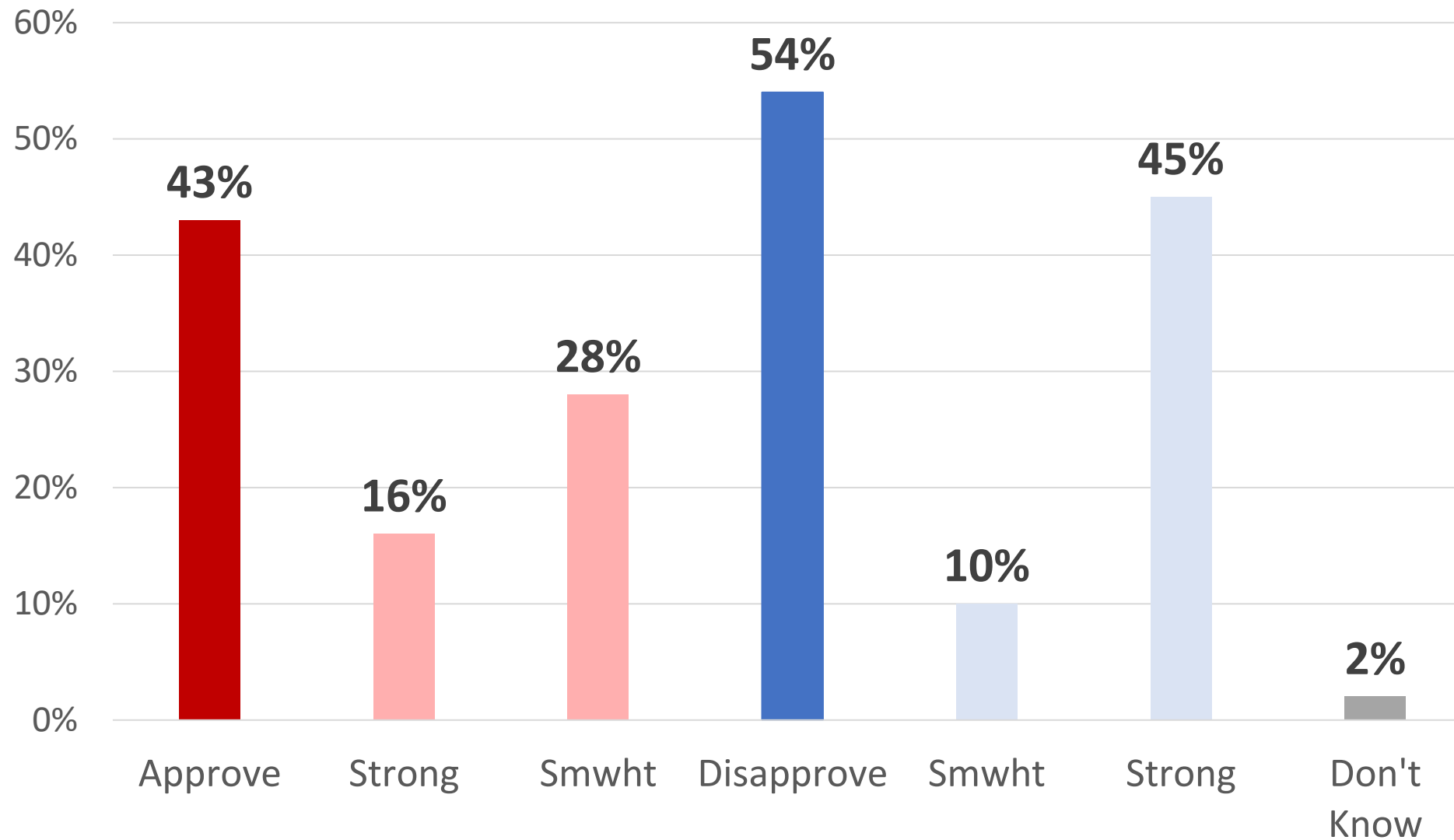


# Direction of Connecticut



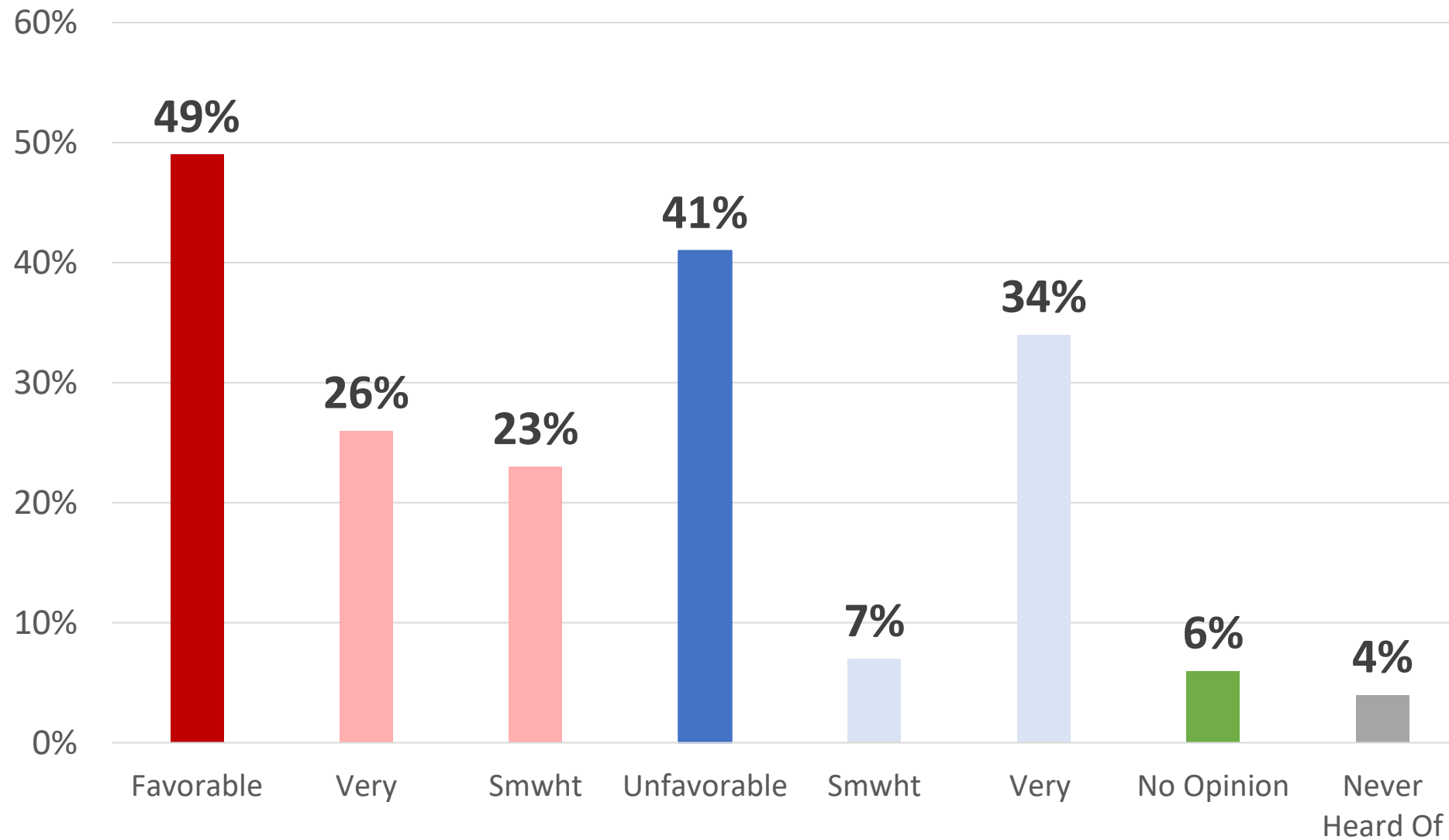
