Methodology

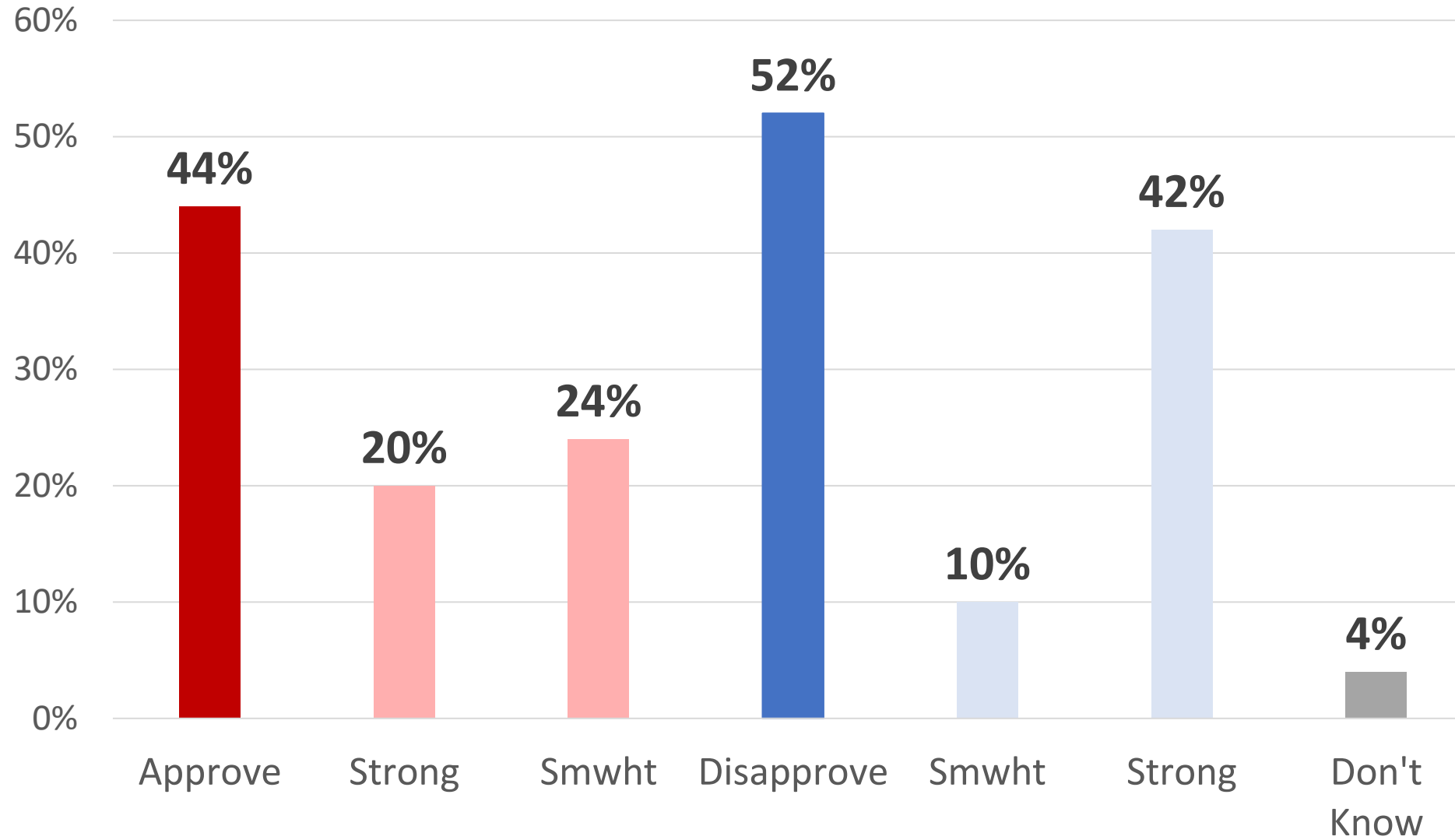
This New York statewide survey was conducted among 600 likely general election voters between August 7-9, 2022.

Interviews included a mix of landline phone, mobile phone, and text-to-web. Interview selection was at random within predetermined election units. These units were structured to statistically correlate with actual statewide general election voter turnout.

The accuracy of the sample of 600 likely general election voters is within +/- 4.0% at a 95% confidence interval.

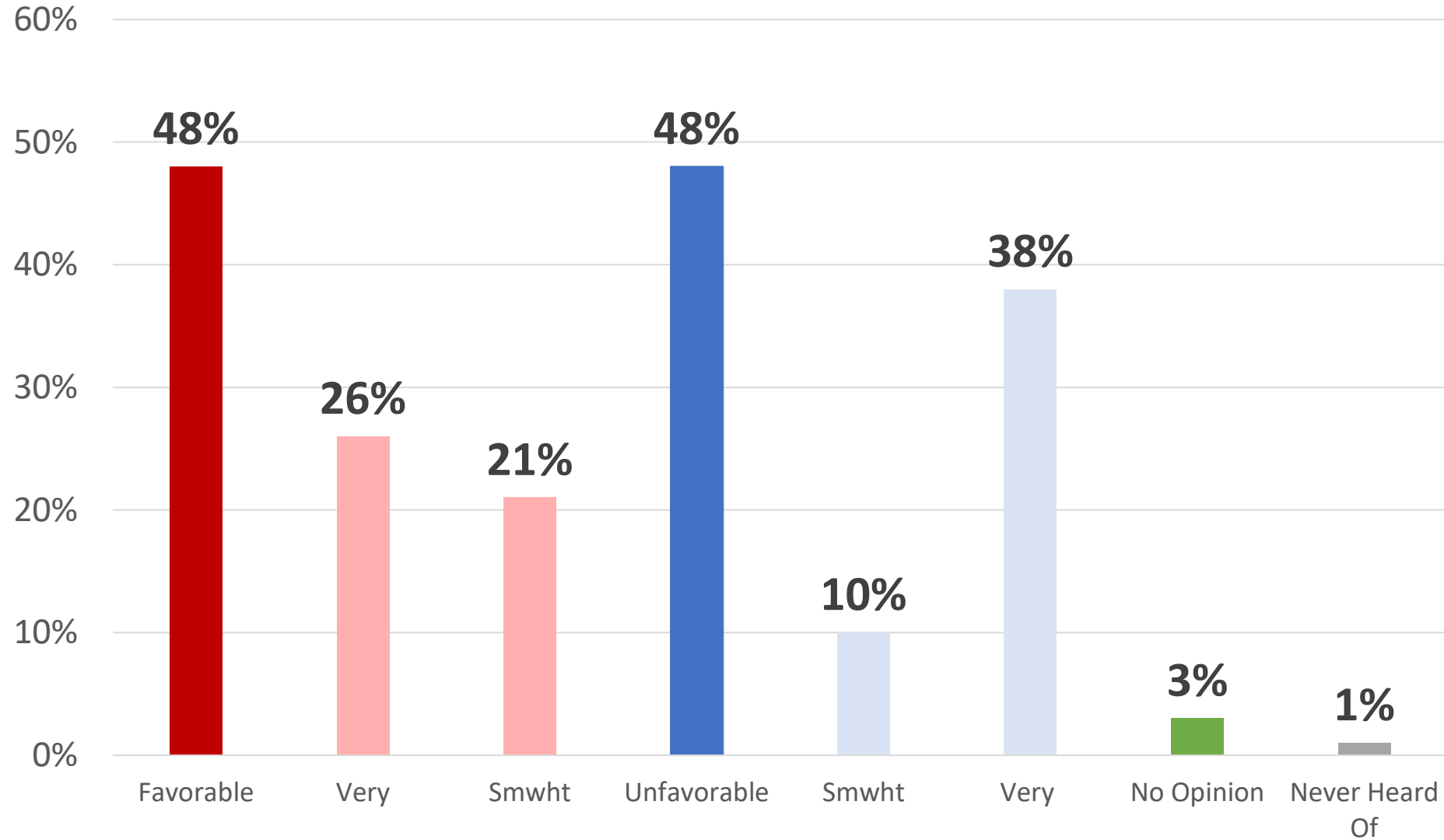


Joe Biden Job Approval



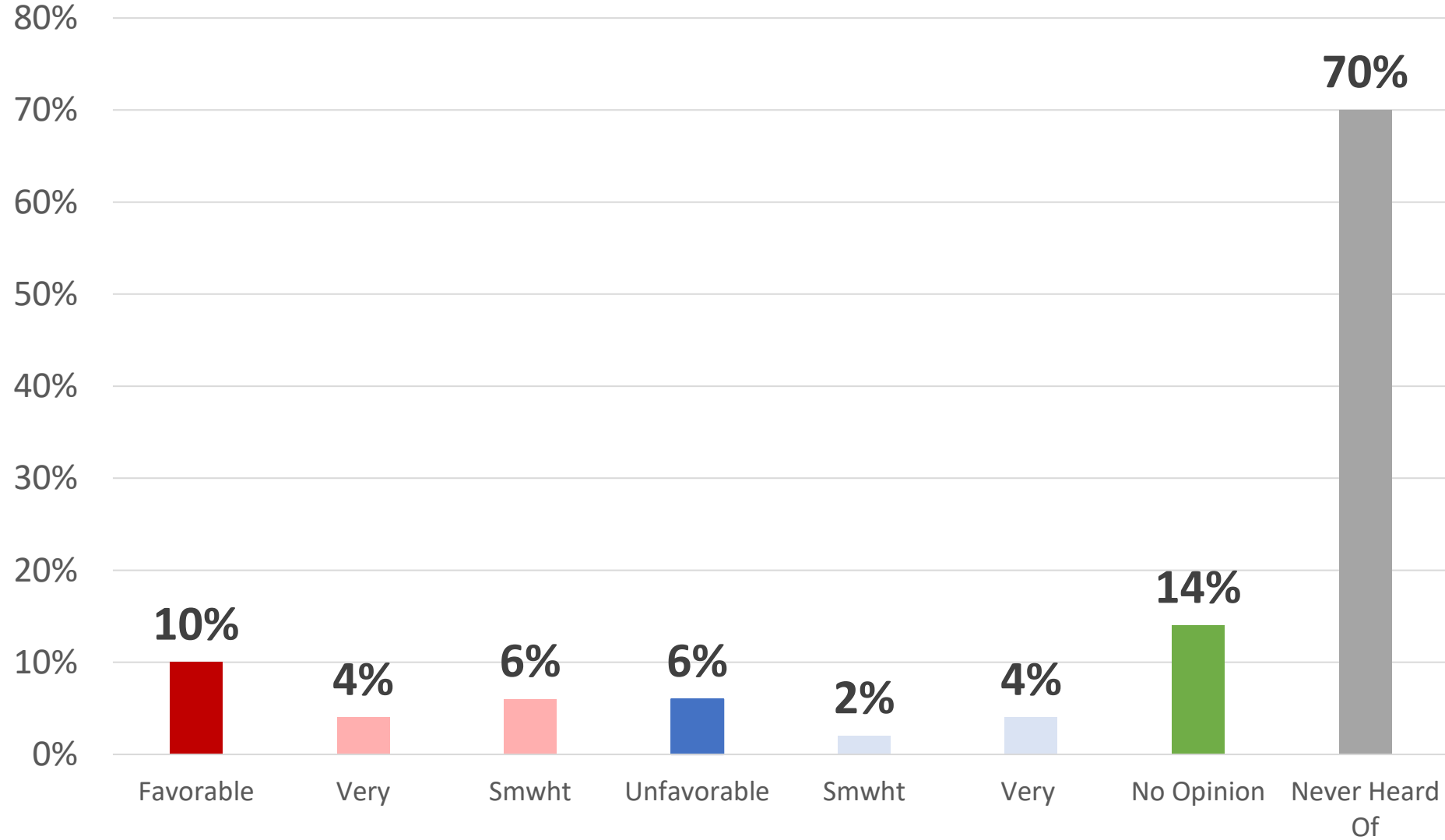
