
# 2024 UNITED STATES ELECTION OBSERVER



### Methodology

The survey was conducted among 1,600 likely general election voters in 17 election battleground states between February 15-20, 2023. Included, is a sample of 737 Republican primary voters.

The interview distribution was structured to correlate with the electoral college vote by state (Arizona, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Maine, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Mexico, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Texas, Virginia, and Wisconsin). The survey sample reflects the demographics of a likely voter universe.


The accuracy of the 1,600 likely general election voter sample is +/- 2.5% at a 95% confidence interval. The accuracy of the 737 Republican primary election voter sample is +/- 3.6% at a 95% confidence interval. The numbers in this presentation have been rounded and may not equal 100%.






### Republican Primary for President











How concerned are you about the war between Russian and Ukraine escalating into World War 3, or a nuclear conflict between the United States and Russia?

**1.** U.S. should stop the conflict and bring Russia and Ukraine to the peace talks.


**2.** U.S. should continue or escalate the conflict to defeat Russian President Vladimir Putin.




