
Was your vote for Donald Trump more of a vote for Donald Trump or more of a vote against Kamala Harris? (n=508)





What was the single most important reason you voted for Kamala Harris? n=475




Was your vote for Joe Biden more of a vote for Kamala Harris or more of a vote against Donald Trump? (n=475)


When did you decide how you were going to vote for President?







What was the single most important reason you voted Republican? (n=483)










Was your vote more for the Democratic candidate and their policies or more of a vote against Donald Trump and the Republican policies? (n=478)





When did you decide how you were going to vote for your Representative in Congress? (n=980)





Do you think it's President Joe Biden's fault that the United States is on the wrong track? (n=629)





Generally speaking, do you think the national news media was more biased against Donald Trump or they were more biased against Kamala Harris?






Thinking about a political party, would you consider yourself a...?



On the issue of abortion, do you consider yourself pro-life or pro-choice?


